 Once the Merchant has authorised the Partner to take Embedded Payments on their behalf, Tyro will notify the Partner of the Merchant ID (MID) via API (preregistered webhook URL).

• The Partner will need to maintain a MID list for the POS customer so that when a merchant adds devices, only MIDs owned by the merchant are offered. To help facilitate this mapping process, the posReference passed through to the Integration Portal is returned with each MID notification.
